It was a packed week for the Lookbox Living team – and those in the design industry – as we hopped from one design venue to another from March 10 to 22. Here are some highlights:

FIFTY YEARS OF SINGAPORE DESIGN

The DesignSingapore Council unveiled its contribution to the SG50 celebrations during design week: Fifty Years of Singapore Design is on exhibit at the National Design Centre until December 2017. It's an eye-opening showcase of the country's design history – for example, did you know that the Le Cube Portable Radio Cassette Recorder by Philips was designed here in the 1980s?

SINGAPLURAL

The Singapore Furniture Industries Council (SFIC) gathered all design installations in one space, 99 Beach Road – and we thought that was a great idea. From professional collaborations, such as Lamitak's Project X, to the student installations from La Salle College of the Arts, Raffles Design Institute and other design schools, you could see local creativity abound.



MAISON & OBJET ASIA

The international home, decoration and design fair that originated from Paris, France, had a successful second year in Singapore, with more regional brands launching here, such as Singapore-based Departures & Arrivals featuring Filipino designer Ito Kish. European design names were here, too, such as interior designer Kelly Hoppen, who introduced her new bathroom collection for Apaiser, and furniture brand Frato, whose Borghese chair made its international debut at Maison & Objet Asia.

INTERNATIONAL FURNITURE FAIR SINGAPORE

Capping off the week was the International Furniture Fair Singapore, which presented a retrospective of the Furniture Design Awards, introduced Asian Star designers, and brought furniture and furnishing exhibitors from all over the world to Changi Expo. Brands sold by local retailers, such as D-Bodhi at Journey East, launched their new collections at this fair.
