To get the look, also use Lamitak's High Gloss Black laminate to finish the shelving.

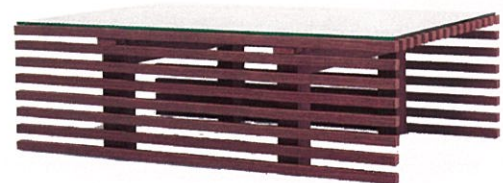
Modern yet cosy, the concrete and steel look calls for a touch of industrial chic, which you can find in furniture and decor accessories.

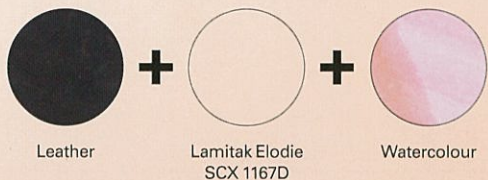

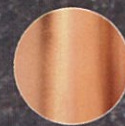
